

Sports Information Sheet

In recognizing the serious nature of the Covid - 19 pandemic and the positive impact that participation in MSHSL fine arts activities and athletics has on student participants, it is imperative that students and families know and understand the following:

- Participating in MSHSL activities is voluntary.
- While participating in MSHSL activities, all laws as well as MSHSL and school rules, guidelines, and protocols related to COVID-19 must be followed.
- Participant acknowledges the contagious nature of COVID-19, and the Participant understands that there is risk of injury and/or illness from participating in MSHSL activities, including the risk to have direct or indirect contact with individuals who have been exposed to and/or diagnosed with COVID-19.
- Participant agrees that if he/she is exposed to, or infected by, COVID-19 during the period of participation, they will immediately cease participation and follow Minnesota Department of Health protocols for schools and activities and MSHSL guidelines for notification and return to participation.
- Participant has signed a separate Eligibility Statement connected to general participation in MSHSL athletics/activities and agrees that the terms of that statement are wholly incorporated into this document and that the terms of this document are incorporated into the Eligibility Statement.

Volleyball

At this time under current covid guidelines set by the MN Department of Health and Education, no spectators are allowed at indoor events.

JV and C squad players are allowed at the varsity match wearing a mask and socially distanced.

Football

At this time under current covid guidelines set by the MN Department of Health and Education, 250 spectators will be allowed on school campus.

Spectators need to remain socially distanced from one another by family group.

Mask use by all spectators is strongly recommended.

Spectators must wear masks when entering or exiting the facility and when social distancing is not possible.

Ticket Sales

1. 150 tickets will be divided up equally between players, cheerleaders and coaches.
2. Opposing team will be returning unsold tickets to the athletic office by Thursday morning.
3. Ticket prices are \$6
4. Tickets are numbered so when they are purchased you will also have to provide the name of the person who will be using the ticket. You need to purchase tickets before they will be given out.
5. Game night tickets will be collected as you enter the parking lot. Signs will be posted on where to enter the lot.
6. Gate to the parking lot will open at 6:30pm or one half hour before game time.
7. When entering the fan will need to provide their ticket and identification.
8. Students 16 and under will be accompanied by an adult.

Parking/Stadium entrance

Parking will only be allowed in the HS parking lot.

Signs will be posted. Entrance will be by door #3 between the HS and Elementary.
Home fans will enter through the ticket booth by the press box.

Concessions will not be provided.

Transportation

It is highly recommended that parents drive their son/daughter to and from away events. We have been providing our athletes with social distancing practices on the bus. This is to help with contact tracing. The County Health Department has now stated, if the bus ride is longer than 30 minutes all people (athletes, coaches, driver) on the bus, even those greater than 6 feet from the positive case, would be considered a close contact. The fewer athletes we have riding the bus the better.

A permission form will need to be filled out 24 hours prior to the event and turned into the athletic office. You will receive an email from skyward that will contain the form. Please make copies of it. Each event will require a new form. Forms can also be picked up at the HS athletic office.

Athletes must be accompanied by a parent or adult age family member (18+ and not in school) when being transported to away events. Failure to follow this rule will result as a violation of the MSHSL Code of Conduct.

If your son or daughter is going to ride with a non-family member you will also be required to fill out a permission form and will need to be turned into the athletic office 24 hours prior to the

event. The person your son or daughter will be riding with must be a parent or adult age family member of a teammate.

Live Streaming Events

At this time all home events will be streamed on the Holdingford Activities Facebook page. The event will be streamed live and will be saved to watch at a later date.

We are currently working on a YouTube channel for streaming our home events. More information will be available.
